Just Wait (Ga. 4:4-5)

I managed to not curse anyone or throw anything. But it did get me to thinking about just how often we do wait. We wait to check out at the grocery store; we wait to get our cars inspected or repaired; we wait for the kids to finish practicing some sport or activity; we wait for our dry cleaning; we wait for test results from a teacher or doctor; we wait for our wives to get their makeup on and our husbands to fix their hair. 
