# Teaching and Training Kids That Rock for Jesus

Follow the Children

As a kid, my role model was Bart Starr (quarterback for the Green Bay Packers). When I played football with the kids in my neighborhood, I would always act like him. Most kids have an adult role model they dream of being like. There is nothing wrong with that. But did you know that Jesus said adults needed to be like you? Read Luke 18:15-17. In these verses, Jesus is using children as an example for adults. Parents were bringing their kids to Jesus so that He could say a blessing or prayer over them. While one of the children was on His lap, Jesus said for all to hear, "Whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it at all" (verse 17). Basically, Jesus was saying that adults needed to have the faith of a child if they were going to be saved so they could one day live in heaven. Unlike adults, most kids do not worry about all the things they cannot understand. They simply trust Jesus. Spiritual faith is trusting in Jesus even though you cannot see Him with your eyes or hear Him with your ears. All people (child and adult) are expected to follow Jesus by obeying what He says in the Bible and what He leads them to do in theirs hearts. When you trust Jesus in simple faith, you provide an example for all grownups to follow. I hope you have trusted Jesus to save you. If not please speak with your mom or dad or Sunday School teacher or me and we will help you know Jesus. I love you in Jesus and I am very proud of you.

**Need**: Bagged lunch, sunscreen, walking shoes (a lot to cover). We will provide water, drinks and a snack for the trip.


Must let Ms. Charlotte know by June 5 if you plan to attend. Permission form and medical form must be completed and returned.


New T-shirts are being printed. You will receive them before our first summer fun day.
