Father The other day I watched from my kitchen window as a squirrel sat in the bird bath in my backyard eating seed placed there for birds. He was munching for all he was worth. It reminded me of my younger days spent at the buffet at Golden Corral. The thought crossed my mind that the squirrel did not care about where that seed came from. He did not care about what it cost me. He did not even care that it was not for him. He simply was enjoying the moment and all that was available.

That squirrel reminds me of God's children. Many times we enjoy everything that comes from our Father in heaven. We bask in salvation, forgiveness, peace, joy, love, and an abundance of daily provisions without giving much thought of where it came from or what it cost. It is not our intent to be ungrateful, but that is how it must seem to the LORD. Each day we should stop and take an inventory of the blessings afforded us as children of God. This is what King David did in Psalm 103 when he wrote, "May I never forget the good things he does for me. ³He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. ⁴He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies. ⁵ He fills my life with good things" (vv. 2-5, NLT). This did not reflect every blessing that God had given David. But it was a reminder, in that moment, of how faithful and gracious God was to him.

Today, and every day, we should take a moment and reflect on the goodness and graciousness of God. Pause and look up to the heavens and remember just how much God loves you—and be grateful for how He demonstrates His divine care. Blessings in Christ.




