From the It was around 6:00 am and I was fast asleep. When all of a sudden I heard a noise that made me sit up in bed. Without

any warning a large oak tree at the back of my yard fell to the ground with a crash. It startled me so that I became wide awake. I went out to inspect the damage and began the process of contacting those (insurance, tree removal, fence company) who would be able to help repair the damage.

It reminded me of a passage of scripture that I just recently read. "Whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: ²⁵ and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. ²⁶ "But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: ²⁷ and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall" (Mt. 7:24-28).

Most of us can remember an incident when a wellknown spiritual leader or religious figure was discovered to have been engaged in sinful activity. However, this can happen to anyone of us, regardless of our position or status in life. In our passage, Jesus makes it clear that "whoever" builds their life on a biblical foundation will be safe and secure. But "everyone" who does not apply the truth to his or her life is in danger of falling. The Bible is not just a book filled with interesting stories and whimsical advice. It is Divine truth that was given to help us bring God glory in this world.

If Christians have God's word to help them, why do they fall? Some folks get the order wrong. They try to change their ways without first having their hearts changed. This is an impossible task. Sooner or later our hearts will betray us. What we truly love will be revealed and reinforced by our actions. However, we must remember that only God can change a heart (Ezekiel 36:26). If we love God with all our heart, then living for Him will come natural. We will not struggle to apply Divine truth to our daily lives. And when the storms come we will be able to weather them.

It always grieves me to hear that a believer has fallen into one of Satan's traps. Make sure you do not become a casualty of life. Let God's word change your heart and life today. Blessings in Christ.


