What Can We Do?

I am sure most of you have heard about the announcement Disney made the other day. If not here is a synopsis of it all. Earlier this year, the state of Florida passed the "Parental Rights in Education Bill," which prohibits public schools from indoctrinating children grades K-3 with pro-gay, pro-transgender propaganda. In response, Disney announced it will restore a previously cut lesbian kissing scene in its June Pixar release of the kid's movie "Lightyear."

In addition, the President, bolstered by documents from Health and Human Services, recently revealed his intentions to support transgenderism by purposely encouraging unnatural, unhealthy, and irreversible surgery for youth who desire to modify their sexuality.

Sadly, that is only the tip of the iceberg of the liberal assault on the parental right to control what and when your children learn regarding human sexuality. At times the assault against conservative, Christian values seems overwhelming—we are unsure what to do. The other Wednesday night someone asked me what they could do. Below are some suggestions.

1. It is vitally important you become aware of what is taking place in local, state, & federal government. We do not have the luxury of trusting that Judeo-Christian values will be reflected in our leadership. Ignorance is no excuse.
2. Speak out against ungodly, unnatural, acts (or the legalization of them) that violate the divine design of human sexuality & therefore undermine the family unit & the nation.
3. Regularly, contact government leaders & voice your opinion regarding what you think & expect them to do. Those people are supposed to represent you!
4. If politicians violate your trust, hold them accountable by removing them from office the next election. The issue here is bigger than partisan politics!
5. Make sure you talk to your children & grandchildren about what they are being taught at school. Peruse their iPads or textbooks. Read their assignments or school handouts.
6. Go to PTO meetings, & school board meetings, and ask pertinent questions. Do not be intimidated by rhetoric, insinuations, or threats.

7. Volunteer to assist a teacher or class. Not only will you be a blessing to a teacher & the children, but you will be able to observe firsthand what is being taught to your children.
8. Not all public school teachers are like ours at FBCC who live with a biblical worldview. If you discover a teacher or school is involved in teaching something with which you disagree or do not wish your child be taught, respectfully confront them in the presence of the principal. Remember, teachers are paid with tax dollars—they work for you!
9. Run for a seat on the school board or a local political office to get more Christian thought & leadership into our community.
10. Take a stand. Avoid supporting any company financially who supports the liberal agenda to distort human sexuality. Do not take your children to Disney World or movies produced by Pixar or any other affiliate of Disney!

Some of you may think this is a political issue and as such, I am overstepping my area of focus as a spiritual leader. Generally speaking, I prefer to stay out of politics, but this is too important. What leaders decide in Washington and Richmond is going to affect our homes, our churches, and our lives as citizens of the United States. The Bible says, *"Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people" (Pr. 14:34)*. I would remind you that those who follow Jesus are His ambassadors (**2 Cor. 5:20**). Do not allow ungodly ideology to take over your country without a fight. Be salt & light in this world. Whatever it takes, make sure you represent King Jesus!

This fund drive is for the purpose of providing financial support for two much needed maintenance projects at our church. The sanctuary roof was in dire need of replacement and it was the first maintenance item to be addressed. We actually had water leaking into the sanctuary.

The other much needed maintenance issue is our parking lots. We have three areas of major concern, each of which will be addressed as the funds become available.

This is why we chose "**Leave A Legacy**" as our campaign slogan. Think of all those church members before you that left a legacy for us by financially supporting earlier giving campaigns. Now it's our chance to thank those early donors and also a chance to pay it forward to future generations of church members.

This campaign officially kicked off at the May 1st. church wide picnic and will continue for a three year pledge period. Pledge cards were handed out at the picnic and there will be a collection ceremony held on Sunday, May 15 during worship service. Pledge cards will be available in the sanctuary on the day of this event. Note: If you would like a pledge card prior to this event you may go by the church office and pick one up, during regular operating hours. Also, if you can't be in attendance for the ceremony, you may drop off your pledge card at any time at the church office.

The pledge cards will allow you to make a campaign pledge for anything from a one time gift to a commitment to give for up to three years, ending in 2025. You may give weekly, monthly, annually, etc. as the Lord directs you.

This "**Leave A Legacy**" campaign is for the benefit of our church now and into the future. So pray about it, ask questions if you have them, and do what you are lead to do and may God bless you.

I'll close with **2 Corinthians 9:6-8**

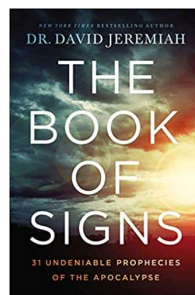

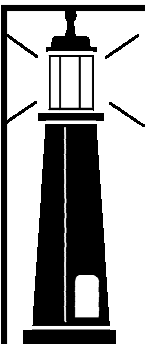
