
JULY CHILDREN'S WORSHIP SCHEDULE:

Affected by ongoing military conflict for several years, Ukraine is home to thousands of people without a home. Linda brings light to a dismal situation. She disciples Ukrainian Christians and helps them meet the physical and spiritual needs of the displaced persons she has given the hope-filled nickname "not-yet-believers".
