Last month, I provided you with the first half from a blog by Gary Chapman. To jog your memory, the first word Gary

focused on in relation to the Greek word arête was "excellence." This half contains the second word associated with arête. Hope the message challenges you.

And then there is purpose, our response to the question, "Why?" Why did God create me to live here and now? And why does my life matter at all in the bigger scheme of things? As a general rule, most of us seek purpose, realizing that simply meandering through life results in meaninglessness. By living purposefully, we're better able to invest finite time and energy.

When I think of purpose, a snapshot in the life of Nehemiah comes to mind. You'll recall God planted a vision in him that Jerusalem's wall must be rebuilt. Armed with that purpose, Nehemiah took all the necessary steps to get the project underway, encouraging the citizens to aid in the construction. Along the way, he had to deal with some who sought to take financial advantage of the situation. As is often true for leaders, he encountered ridicule from those opposed to the project. Finally, his adversaries resorted to physical threats. Even then, Nehemiah insisted, "I'm doing a great work; I can't come down from this wall." That is purpose.

When circumstances conspire to discourage us or tempt us to throw in the towel, purpose offers renewed hope. In short, purpose adds joy to our existence, overcoming even the drudgery that so often accompanies daily life. And, as our life's story begins to draw to a close, we can look back with fewer regrets as we view the legacy we leave for those coming behind us.






