# What's Your Story?

Cone day last month Jan had a visit from a member of the local Jehovah's Witness group. Jan did

not have a conversation with this lady, but she did accept material the woman was handing out. About a week later Jan received a four page, hand-written letter from that woman extolling the virtues of the Jehovah's Witness faith. It seems there was a large gathering in Roanoke and this lady wanted Jan to attend. Now I neither support the Jehovah's Witness denomination, nor accept their doctrine as Christian. But I must give this lady credit for her commitment to her faith. I dare say not many of us have ever written a four page letter to someone we hardly knew in an attempt to share our faith with them—including me.

Peter tells us we are to, "always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you" (1 Peter 3:15). We do not have to write a long letter in order for others to know about the Lord Jesus. If you think that is what it requires to bring a lost friend or family member to faith in Christ, then start writing. However, all we need do is share what is in our hearts. If you are saved, then you have a testimony about what the Lord has done for you. An effective witness for Christ shares 3 things: 1.) What your life was like before you met Jesus; 2.) How you came to Christ; 3)What your life has been like since meeting Jesus. That's it! Don't worry about the results. It is the responsibility of the Holy Spirit to use your story in bringing a person to faith in Christ. Like that lady who wrote to Jan, you have nothing to lose. So go ahead tell your story. Who knows, God may use it to gloriously save someone.
