The other day I came by a home located in my neighborhood. The homeowners had just cut down a beautiful

oak tree in their front yard. It was tall, with long limbs stretching out in all directions. The limbs provided shade in the hottest days of the summer and a safe place for birds and squirrels to nest. In the fall season those leaves would have changed to shades of red, yellow, and orange, adding wonderful color to the upcoming holiday season. Upon seeing the downed tree, my first thought was, 'What a waste!' But as I passed by, I could see that the inner part of the tree was hollow. Something had rotted away the core of the tree. This had made the tree susceptible to strong winds during summer storms and heavy ice during winter weather. Had the homeowners not cut the tree down it could have fallen over and destroyed their home, their car, or even injured one of them.

In regards to a tree, it would be safe to say that what is inside is very important. But the same can be said of a human as well. Most likely you have seen someone who looked like the picture of health, only to discover they were battling some form of cancer. As with our health, what is inside a person, spiritually speaking, is just as important. On one occasion, Jesus told the Pharisees they were "like whitewashed tombsbeautiful on the outside but filled on the inside with dead people's bones and all sorts of impurity" (Mt. 23:27, NLT). Jesus did not necessarily have a problem with their actions—He took issue with their attitudes. They were okay so far as religion went, but they had no relationship with the LORD. The Pharisees should have taken a good, long look at their hearts. Today, we should do the same thing. Make sure nothing is eating away in the hidden places of your being. If you discover something is wrong fix it before it goes too far.
