While driving home, I saw the most magnificent rainbow I have ever seen. It seemed wider than other rainbows and its colors were so vivid and beautiful. In that moment, I was reminded that God has promised He would never again destroy the earth with a flood (Genesis 9:8-17). The rainbow is a sign of the covenant that God made with Noah. As I drew closer to home, I passed a house where a woman was in the front yard with her children. They were looking at the rainbow. I could not help but wonder if she was telling those kids about the biblical account of the rainbow.

God wants us to tell others about Him. To assist us in this endeavor, He has provided some amazing accounts in the Bible. Noah and the ark; Moses and a burning bush; David and Goliath; Daniel in a den of lions; three Hebrew boys in a fiery furnace; the Virgin Mary giving birth to Jesus; the resurrection of Christ. And these are just a few accounts that we can use to tell people about our awesome God.

However, the most compelling account you can tell is your personal story. Jesus told the man in Gadara who had been healed from demonic possession to tell people "everything the Lord has done for you" (Mark 5:19). There is no one else who has a story like yours. 
