Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes Update

For Martinsville, Henry County and Franklin County there were 9936 shoeboxes, 1200 special access shoeboxes and 209 shoeboxes built online for a total of 11,345 for our area. We think there will be more online boxes, but this is what has been recorded so far.

This means that with the influence of families of recipients that about 66,000 people will hear the Gospel, 4538 children will be enrolled in the Greatest Journey classes and 2382 will make decisions to follow Christ. Isn't that wonderful to think our area will affect that many people—a simple shoebox with the Gospel message.

A special thank you to each person who packed boxes and prayed over the boxes. A special thank you to the churches that were drop off centers for the boxes—Chatham Heights Baptist, Stone Memorial, Crosspoint, Halesford, Franklin Heights, Boones Mill and Faith Assembly of God.

Just wanted our people to know they are missionaries—big time through the shoeboxes.


