# AN EARTH SHAKING EXPERIENCE (Matthew 27:45-56)

I expect most of us have seen news reports of an earthquake and the impact it had on an area. In some cases, the devastation was so great that it took years for the community to recover. However, the Bible records an instance when an earthquake caused a series of amazing events. Rather than destroy, this earthquake paved the way for a fresh start for many people.

When Jesus died on the cross it set off a chain reaction. First, the curtain in the temple was torn in two. Then, some Christians who had previously died and were buried arose from their graves and entered Jerusalem. The Bible does not say what those people did after resurrecting. Just that other people living in Jerusalem saw and recognized them. Finally, the Roman soldiers responsible to see that Jesus and the other two men were crucified acknowledged Jesus as the "Son of God."

These events are significant. The curtain separated the Holy Place of the temple from the Most Holy Place. The Most Holy Place was where God resided and only the High Priest was allowed to enter. According to Jewish law, a dead body was unclean and any living person who came into contact with a dead body was considered unclean as well. The soldiers had been a part of this process from the beginning. They heard the accusations brought against Jesus. They saw how He conducted Himself thru the trial, beating, and time on the cross. They did not believe Jesus was the Son of God when the ordeal began, but they did when the day ended.

Matthew is showing that Jesus' death changed the relationship of Holy God to this world. The torn curtain tells us that every human can come into the presence of God. There is no need to have someone speak to God on our behalf. We are encouraged to come boldly into God's presence. The resurrected believers confirm not only the power of Jesus to overcome death, but the ability to cleanse those who were formerly considered unclean. Finally, the statement of the Roman soldiers lets us know that if those who are lost will review the evidence they will come to believe in Jesus as God's Son and trust Him as their Savior.

At the moment Jesus died on the cross, our sins were paid for. If we will place our trust in Jesus, we are forgiven and cleansed from all our sin. And one day we too will be raised from the grave to live forever with God in heaven. That's earth-shaking, rock-shattering news!


# Fond Memories, Fresh Beginnings
