It Hurts So Good

As I continue to age, I often remember moments of my childhood. Fortunately, not all those memories are pleasant. Yes, you heard me right. It is "fortunate" for me that not all my memories are pleasant. How can that be? Most of what I have learned has come through failure and adversity rather than success and comfort.

I would venture to say that at one time or another you heard a parent say, "This is for your own good." If you did have the misfortune to hear this phrase it was right before you received a spanking for some transgression. In that moment, you probably thought your mom or dad had lost his or her mind. However, when you became an adult, you realized your parents were right. Discipline, while not pleasant for an adult or a child is beneficial.

As our Heavenly Father, God sometimes has to discipline us. When that happens we must see discipline from the father's eyes. Listen to what the Bible says: *"My child, don't make light of the LORD's discipline, and don't give up when he corrects you.* ⁶ For the LORD disciplines those he loves, and he punishes each one he accepts as his

child" (Hebrews 12:5-6, NLT).

Those verses provide a child of God with several principles to remember:

God is the source of discipline

He disciplines all of His children

He always acts out of love

In the midst of divine discipline, one might question why a loving God would want to inflict pain on those He loves. One reason is that divine discipline gets our attention—or it will if we are smart. A second reason is that it corrects improper behavior. And finally, it proves that we belong to God (Hebrews 12:8). Just like our earthly parents, God knows that discipline is beneficial to those who will view it in the proper light.

The Heavenly Father will never discipline you out of rage or selfish desire. He will never lose control. His actions are intended to nudge you toward the life and character you desire but cannot reach without His guidance. We can trust the heart of God even when He disciplines us. Pastor Larry
