I Pledge Allegiance

" . . . to Me every knee will bow, every tongue will swear allegiance. (Isaiah 45:23, NASB)

Hi folks. I was thinking the other day about how much things have changed since I was a boy. I expect that, like me, many of you began each day of school with organized prayer and reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Most public schools do neither today.

Recently, I read an article that suggested Christians should not say the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag because it was idolatrous to pledge to anything other than God. While I DO NOT believe saying the Pledge of Allegiance is idolatrous, I DO AGREE it is important Christians understand they have an allegiance to God.

Allegiance comes from the Latin word [alligo] meaning to bind. In feudal times people were bound to a king or the lord of a manor (a superior). Some other words that may be derived from the original Latin word are alliance and league. The concept behind these words is that an individual has a responsibility to be faithful to some cause, some group, or some person.

The Bible teaches us that God expects His people to be faithful. Faithfulness is a fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22). Plus, faithfulness has its rewards. The writer of the letter to the Hebrews penned, "If we are faithful to the end, trusting God just as firmly as when we first believed, we will share in all that belongs to Christ" (Hebrews 3:14, NLT). However, our faithfulness to God must not be based solely on the fact that we will be blessed if we are faithful. We are to be faithful to God because we have pledged our allegiance to Him as our Savior and Lord. To go against our pledge to follow and serve Him would be an affront to our character. God is faithful to us—we must be faithful to Him as well.

This July 4 th be proud that you are an American. Be thankful for the blessings that are yours as a citizen of the United States. But most of all, be faithful to God as a member of His kingdom.




