I was perusing through some material the other day and I found this illustration that I think is a

humorous, yet accurate depiction of those who attend church.

A local church is made up of families that are all shapes and sizes. But there is one family that is in every church—the Tater family.

The father, Dick Tater, always has to be the boss. He tells everyone what to do. He wants to be chairman of a committee or leader of a program. If he can't be the boss, he won't come to church at all.

The mother, Sweet Tater, always has something nice to say about everyone. She never insists on having her own way and never gets mad or hurt if she does not get her way. She shows what the Bible calls the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:21-22).

The teenage son, Speck Tater, just doesn't want to get involved. He doesn't want any jobs, he just wants to sit back and watch everyone else do the work. Of course, if they don't do it to suit him, he will be the first to criticize and find fault.

The daughter, Emma Tater, is more concerned with appearance than reality. She worries more about what she wears to church than what happens at church. On Sundays, she acts the part of a Christian, but during the week, one would never know she even believes there is a God. She is quick to tell you she is a follower of Christ, but her lifestyle does not support that statement.

That brings us to the Tater tots in the nursery. We don't know how they will turn out, but they will probably look at the other members of the family and decide to be like one of them. Let's hope they make the right choice.

Paul gives us his idea of a local church membership. He told believers in Ephesus, "speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, 16 from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love" (Eph. 4:15-16).

The church is made up of people who voluntarily come together to worship, fellowship, grow, and serve the Lord Christ. Each person is an intricate part of the working of a church and therefore part of the success of that church.

Which member of the Tater family would you be? Your church needs you to be an authentic follower of Jesus!




Book of the Month Mount Vernon Love Story

By Mary Higgins Clark



Always a lover of history, Mary Higgins Clark wrote this extensively researched biographical novel and titled it Aspire to the Heavens, after the motto of George Washington's mother. Published in 1969, the book was more recently discovered by a Washington family descendant and reissued as Mount Vernon Love Story. Dispelling the widespread belief that although George Washington married Martha Dan-

dridge Custis, he reserved his true love for Sally Carey Fairfax, his best friend's wife, Mary Higgins Clark describes the Washington marriage as one full of tenderness and passion, as a bond between two people who shared their lives -- even the bitter hardship of a winter in Valley Forge -- in every way. In this author's skilled hands, the history, the love, and the man come fully and dramatically alive
