Be Steadfast

As I was studying the other day, I came across the word steadfast. Today, that

word is not used very often. But for a Christian it still has huge implications. In Greek "steadfast" [1476, hedraios] is derived from a word that means "to sit." However, it has a much broader meaning than to be sedentary. It indicates a stability that is often missing in the lives of professing Christians.

As Paul finished teaching about the resurrection of deceased believers prior to the Rapture of the Church, he encouraged us to "be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord" (1 Cor. 15:58). Other versions of the Bible chose to use words or phrases that reflected an additional aspect of being steadfast. The NIV calls for us to "stand firm." The New Living Translation says to "be strong and immovable." The New Century Version exhorts us to "stand strong." And The Message says to "stand your ground and don't hold back." In essence, being steadfast means to be firmly fixed in some way.

It seems to me that the idea of being steadfast is more of a mindset than an action. Being steadfast begins with being sure about what you believe and migrates to other aspects of our human existence. King David asked the LORD for a steadfast spirit (Ps. 51:10). He also described his heart as steadfast (Ps. 108:1). Paul encouraged us to be steadfast in prayer (Ro. 12:12). Peter counseled believers to be steadfast in their faith (1 Pet. 5:9). And the writer of the letter to the Hebrews said we should be steadfast in our confidence (Heb. 3:14) and our hope (Heb. 6:19).

But let me say that being steadfast is not obtained through human effort or ingenuity. It is something developed as we trust in the Lord (Ps. 112:7). According to Paul, when we are steadfast, nothing done for the Lord and in the Lord will be in vain. In other words, our lives will be useful and meaningful. What Christian would not want that? Blessings in Christ.


