#### THE REPENTANCE BUTTON

This week has been challenging due to a computer problem at church. My computer is running slow as molasses thru a straw. And when you are in a hurry (as I often am) that is frustrating. An advertisement appeared on the screen offering to clean my hard drive. However, I thought that might be an attempt to hack my computer, so I declined the offer. Therefore, as I write this article I am still dealing with a sluggish computer.

Wouldn't it be nice if we had the option on a regular basis to hit a button and clean up things that are slowing us down in our spiritual lives? Wait a minute, we do have such a thing. It is called repentance. John the Baptist, Jesus, and all the Apostles preached repentance.

In writing to the Corinthian believers, who were at times very worldly, Paul asked a series of questions, "How can righteousness be a partner with wickedness? How can light live with darkness? What harmony can there be between Christ and the devil? How can a believer be a partner with an unbeliever? And what union can there be between God's temple and idols? For we are the temple of the living God" (2 Cor. 6:14-16, NLT). In the first verse of chapter seven Paul exhorted believers to cleanse themselves from anything that defiled their body and spirit (7:1). The rest of chapter seven is Paul's celebration of the church's willingness to repent of their sins.

In his first sermon after being recommissioned by Jesus, Peter preached, "Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord" (Acts 3:19). Confessing our sins and turning (repentance) away from them and toward God will make us feel fresh and clean as a shower at the end of a long, dirty job.

We don't have to feel dirty and exhausted from our battle with sin and worldliness. The Apostle John reassures us that if we confess our sins God will forgive us and cleanse us from any sinful act (1 Jn. 1:9). We find rest, relief, and refreshment when we turn from sin and turn to Jesus. Blessings in Christ.



#### Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup> Humble Hands


