The Lamb and the Lion

Most likely you have heard the saying,

"In like a lion, out like a lamb." This proverb was written to describe March. When March begins it is still winter. Like a lion it is often our coldest, most challenging month weather wise. But by the end of the month spring has begun and we often experience mild, lamb-like, weather that is neither too cold, nor too hot.

As we get ready for Easter, this phrase came to my mind. Probably, in part, due to the series, "Behold the Lamb," I am preaching on Sunday mornings. However, when applied to Jesus this proverb is reversed— "In like a Lamb, out like a Lion."

When Jesus came to this earth the first time, His arrival was mild and calm. He was born in a barn or cave surrounded by animals, with His first crib a feeding trough used by the animals. So it should come as no surprise when John the Baptist referred to Jesus as, "the Lamb of God" (John 1:29). However, this reference actually was looking forward to the moment Jesus would give His life on the cross for the sins of all humanity. Like a mild-mannered lamb Jesus allowed Himself to be crucified.

But the next time Jesus comes to this world, it will be much different. In the book of Hosea, God said, *"I will be like a lion to Israel, like a strong young lion to*

Judah" (Hosea 5:14). A lion is strong, powerful, agile, and rules over its domain with complete authority. In writing about Jesus when He returns, the Apostle John penned in the Revelation, *"The Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David's throne, has won the victory" (Revelation 5:5, NLT)*. A Lion is often referred to as the King of the Jungle." But the Lion of Judah will be King of the entire world. Every aspect of life, every living thing, human, animal, or otherwise will pay homage to the King of the world. He will reign as King of kings and Lord of Lords. That is my Jesus! Hallelujah to the Lamb who is the Lion.
