As a boy, I loved watching the lights on our Christmas tree. Sometimes we used lights that came on and went off at different intervals. And sometimes we used the bulbs that remained on all the time. We even had a carousel with five different colored wedges that continually turned lighting up the entire area around the tree with a plethora of colors. I would lay on the floor for hours and gaze at the tree. There was something very calming and soothing about those lights.

Is it any wonder the Lord Jesus is associated with light. On one occasion He said, *"I am the light of the world"* (Jn. 8:12). He came to give us light so that we would not walk in darkness. In his letter to the Ephesians, Paul exhorted believers to *"walk as children of light"* (Eph. 5:8). You see the light is not there just for us to enjoy, but for us to use. We can use the light to encourage us, to direct us, and to point people to Jesus. Paul told the Philippian believers they were lights to a *"crooked and perverse generation"* (Col. 2:15). We are not to <u>SEE</u> the light only we are expected to <u>BE</u> the light to other people. Jesus is the light of the world and we are reflectors of that light.

No wonder I love to see lights. In those little bulbs of glowing warmth, I find hope. Hope that I can be and do more than I ever imagined possible. Hope that I can experience a close, intimate relationship with the God of the universe thru His Son Jesus. Hope that I might be able to help other people find their way to faith in Christ. As we make our way to Christmas day, I hope you will enjoy all the glitter associated with the season. But each time you see a Christmas light of any kind, I pray you will think about Jesus who is the light of the world. Merry Christmas!'




