**Purfor** It is that time of year again when yardwork has to be done. Some people may not like doing yardwork, but there are benefits to a well-manicured lawn. For one, it is very pleasing to the eye. A well maintained lawn can make an average home look more expensive. A second benefit of a well-kept lawn is that it is a point of pride for the one maintaining it. As a boy, I felt a great sense of pride when I finished mowing the yard. I felt like I had accomplished something worthwhile. That feeling was heightened when my father would comment on how good the yard looked. But my favorite thing about mowing a yard is the smell of cut grass. To me, it has a fresh, clean, sweet smell. I love to roll the window down as I drive so I can smell grass as it is being mowed.

Did you know that smell is important to God? When the Jews would burn incense as a part of their sacrifices to God. The aroma would rise to heaven and bless God. Paul tells us that the sacrifice Jesus made on the cross was a *"pleasing aroma to God"* (Eph. 5:2). As followers of Christ, our lives are expected to be a sweet aroma to God, as well. The Bible says *"We are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing"* (2 Cor. 2:15). How we live our faith really does make a difference. Not just to God, but to other Christians. It even has an impact on those who do not know Christ personally.

Living our faith and maintaining a lawn are very similar. Both require a vision of what we want them to look like before we start. Both require time and effort on our part—they demand our attention when we are tired and don't seem to have enough time. Both require we pay attention to the little things. Weeds left to grow in both will take over eventually. And, if we do them well, both provide us a sense of accomplishment when we look back on our handiwork.

The next time you are riding around the neighborhood, roll your window down and let the smell of fresh, cut grass bless you. And the next time you find yourself in a challenging situation, live you faith so that it will bless God and others.
