FEAR NOT

Hi folks. On several occasions I have heard people say that the phrase "Fear Not" is found in Scripture 365 times (one for each day of the year). That may be true, I have not attempted to count the times it appears myself. However, even if it was only found one time in the Bible, it would be worth us paying attention to God's admonition to "Fear Not!"

Let's take a moment and consider the call to "Fear Not" located in the Christmas story. The angel said it to Zacharias to calm his anxiety and inform him that he and Elizabeth would have a son who would be John the Baptist (Lk. 1:13-14). He said it to Mary to help her accept that her pregnancy was from God (Lk. 1:30). He said it to Joseph to let him know that Mary had remained faithful to him (Mt. 1:20). And he said it to the shepherds to assure them that he meant them no harm (Lk. 2:2:10). It's a natural thing for a human to fear. The more guilt we have, the more things we fear.

But even though it's natural, God sends Jesus with the word, "Fear not!" Hebrews 2:14 says: Jesus became man "that through death he might destroy him who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and deliver all those who through fear of death have been held in lifelong bondage." This last phrase implies something that can be tremendously liberating for our daily lives. If the worst fear—fear of death—has been taken away through the death and resurrection of Christ, then surely God does not want us to fear the lesser things in life like losing a job, or the decline of our health, or the end of a once enjoyable relationship, or missing the game winning shot, or failing a test, or being rejected by someone we like, etc.

The message of Christmas is *fear not*! God rules the world for the great good of his children. Believe his promises: "Fear not for I am with you. Be not dismayed for I am your God. I will help you; I will strengthen you; I will uphold you with the right hand of my righteousness" (Is. 41:10) and "Cast all your anxieties on God because he cares for you" (1 Pet. 5:7). Dear friends, there is nothing to fear when God is with us.


FBCC is preparing breakfast for
