Capital Campaign

The three-year time frame for the Capital Campaign ended as of April 30, 2025. The goal was to raise \$245,000. As of April 28, 2025, \$212,594.07 has been given! The balance remaining in the Capital Campaign Fund is now \$49,524.07. This amount is not enough to complete the parking lot repairs still needed on the John Redd side of the church. Therefore, it was decided in the March Finance & Church Council meeting to continue raising funds. You can continue to give toward the campaign, by designating "Capital Campaign" on your envelope, check memo line, or through your online giving. Any excess or unused funds from the Capital Campaign Fund will go toward other facility and property needs.


Book of the Month
